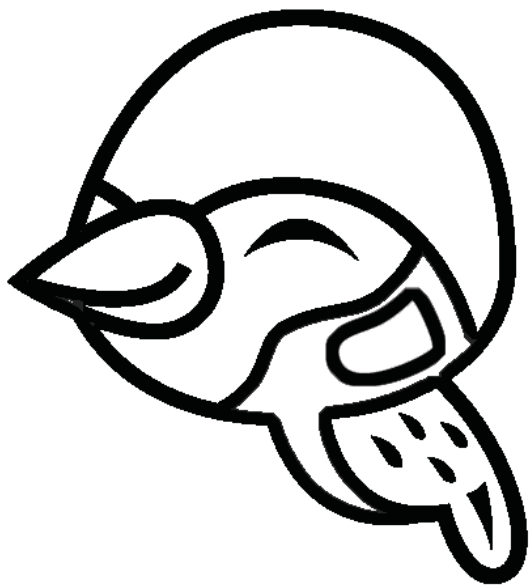

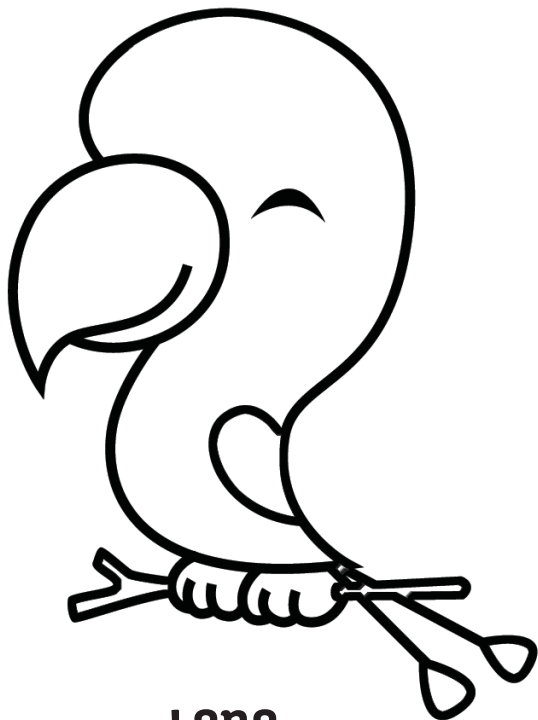

Eurasian Tree Sparrow (*Passer montanus*)



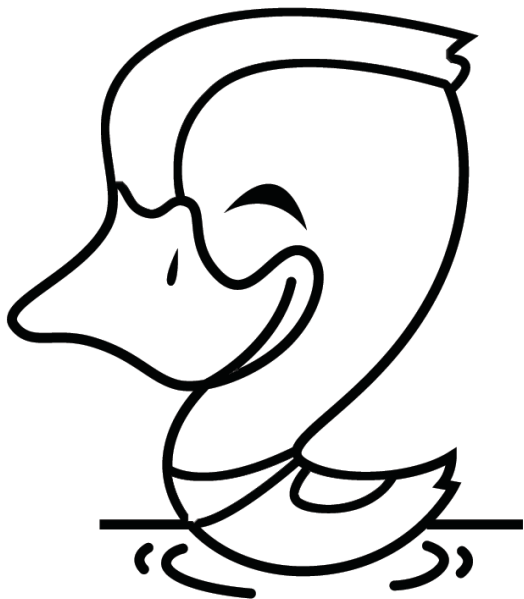
KUWAGO (TAG) or **BOTBOT KUWAW** (PIL)

Visayan Scops-owl (*Otus nigrorum*)



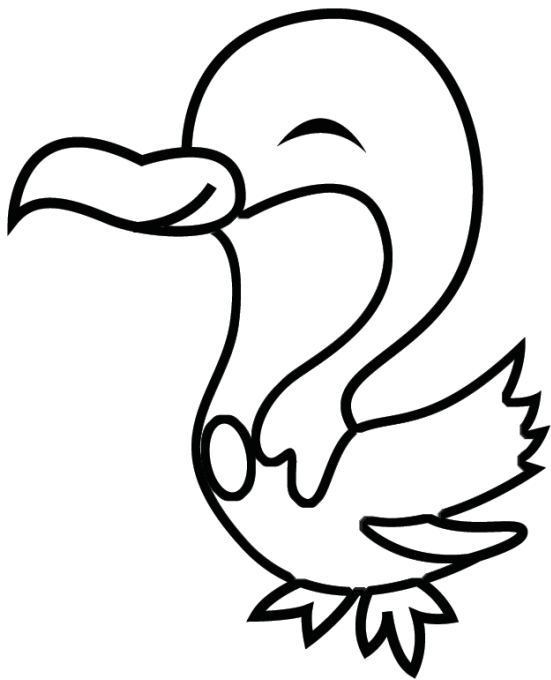
LORO

Green Racquet-tail (*Prioniturus luconensis*)



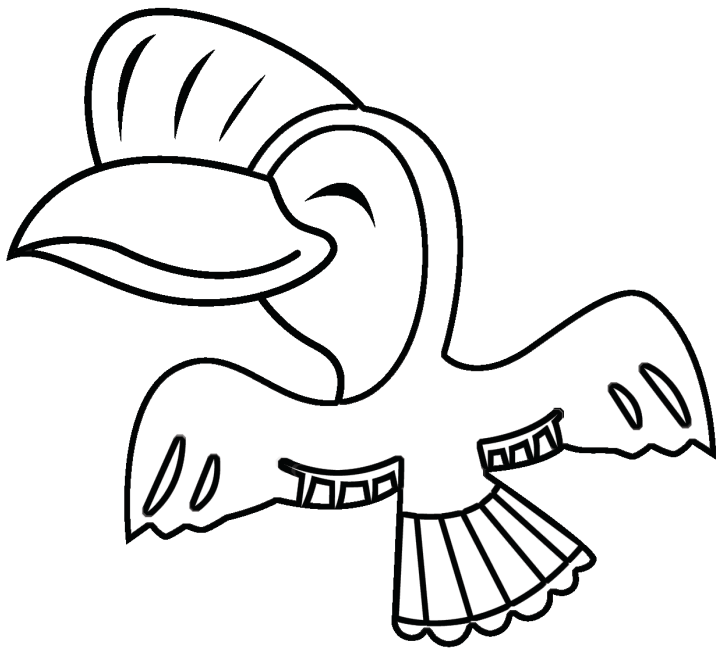
GANSA

Cotton Pygmy-goose (*Nettapus coromandelianus*)



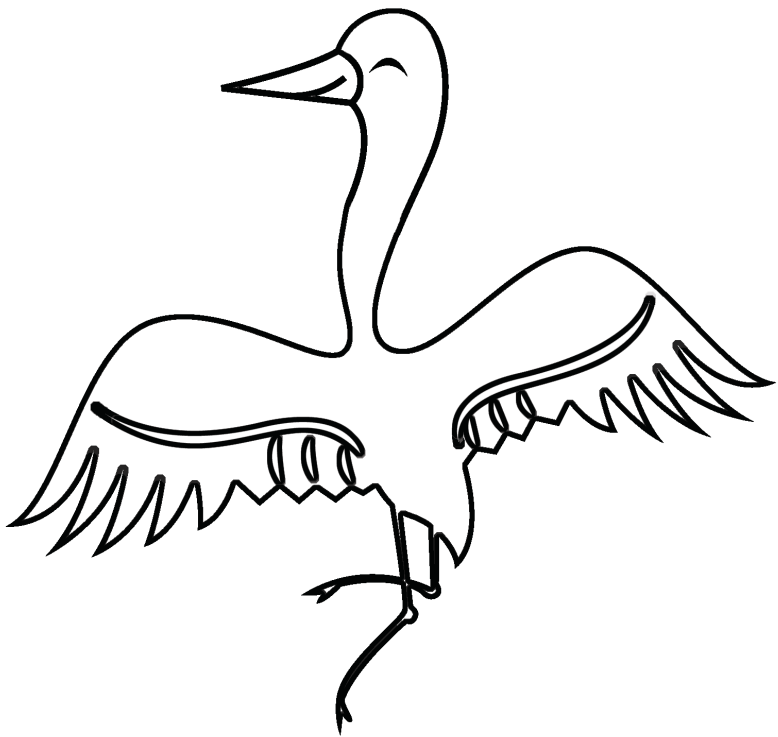
PUNALADA (PIL)
