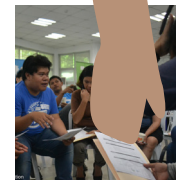

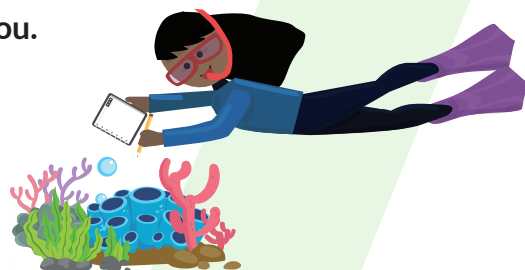
Our species, their habitats.

The Native Tree Nursery

This is the facility where we trek, plant, and learn about native trees.
